- 2. Click 'Edit' from the top menu bar
- 3. From the dropdown menu, click 'Output styles'
- 4. Edit the Vancouver referencing style
- 5. On the left-hand menu bar, under 'Citations', click 'Templates'
- 6. In the templates page, under 'citations' ... default: (Bibliography.Number) ... change to: Bibliography.Number
- 7. Press X and name the citation style (VIVA!)
- 8. Open word file
- 9. In the Endnote on the Word file, pick your edited style as your Output style
